## Name Art Using Lines

```
Learning Intention:
Practise drawing diagonal, vertical and horizontal lines.
Use primary colours.
Success Criteria:
Maintain direction of the lines over the artwork.
Identify primary colours.
Use line and primary colours to create artwork.
```


## Materials:

Paper
Pencil
Colour Pencils
Black marker pen

## Introduction:

## Activity:



1. Students will use 3 primary colours, plus black. Primary colours are red, blue and yellow.
2. Fold paper in half lengthways.
3. Assist student to write their name using straight lines across the middle of the page.
4. Draw lines in sections from the letters of their name to the edge of the paper using primary colour pencils.
5. Vertical lines must be one colour, diagonal lines another colour and horizontal lines, the third colour.
6. Students can trace their name with a black marker
