# Activity:



- Students will use 3 primary colours, plus black. Primary colours are red, blue and yellow.
- 2. Fold paper in half lengthways.
- Assist student to write their name using straight lines across the middle of the page.
- 4. Draw lines in sections from the letters of their name to the edge of the paper using primary colour pencils.
- Vertical lines must be one colour, diagonal lines another colour and horizontal lines, the third colour.
- 6. Students can trace their name with a black marker
