

# **Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2024**

Parent support is crucial in ensuring quality programmes are available to our students. Our Vision Statement states that parents will take shared responsibility for student growth and development. One very important way you can take 'shared responsibility' is to assist the school in providing the much needed resources that supports your child's learning.

<u>School Voluntary Contributions</u> – in line with the School Education Regulations 2000 The Woodland Grove Primary School - School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024, this schedule will allow you to consider possible costs for 2024.

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000. School Board has approved an additional Voluntary Approved Request of \$20.00 per child to support our Chaplain service.

School Voluntary Contributions for 2024 are:

Kindergarten to Year 6 \$60.00 per child
Voluntary Approved Request K-6 -Chaplain \$20.00 per child

Money collected will be used to supplement school funding provided by the government.

While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be enhanced if each family makes a contribution. The contribution level sought represents approximately \$1.50 per student, for each week of the school year.

The areas and costs involved are outlined below:

- Performing and Visual Arts materials

#### **Uniform Shop**
